

Background

In 1992, Ndejje University pioneered private University Education in Uganda and is currently among the **Chartered Private** Universities licensed by the Ministry of Education and Sports to offer Postgraduate and Undergraduate programmes that are fully recognized both nationally and internationally. It enrolls small and manageable classes and maintains high ethical standards of both staff and students. The University humbly began with demand - driven courses in Education and Business at Kampala Campus. Currently it offers over 120 Academic Programmes in 7 Faculties.

Ownership

The University is owned by the six Dioceses of Church of Uganda in central region. However, it is open to / and welcomes all interested students irrespective of creed, tribe or nationality.

Location

Ndejje University operates from two campuses namely, the MAIN CAMPUS, (comprising LADY IRENE Campus as an intergral component) located on Ndejje Hill, 8kms (5 miles) North-West of Bombo Town, 32Kms (20 miles) on Kampala - Gulu Road; and the KAMPALA CAMPUS at Mengo, on Plot 151, Balintuma Road including the GRADUATE SCHOOL located on Muteesa I Road, Rubaga Hill, near Rubaga Hospital and Rubaga Cathedral.

Programmes offered and Fees structure

We offer high quality programmes with reference to stakeholders' needs, and changes have been restricted to enable the University meet its obligations to students and staff in light of the demands of market forces and in response to the requirements of National Council for Higher Education for Quality Assurance purposes.

Undergraduate Degree Programmes (Minimum Entry Requirements)

At least 5 Passes at "0" Level (UCE) or its equivalent and two relevant Principal Passes at "A" Level obtained at the same sitting or its equivalents, or post "0" Level Diploma / Certificate with at least 2 year's relevant experience in the desired field.

Undergraduate Diploma Programmes (Minimum Entry Requirements)

At least 5 Passes at "0" level (UCE) or its equivalent and one relevant Principal Pass and two Subsidiary Passes obtained at the same sitting at "A" Level (UACE) or its equivalent, or post "0" Level Diploma / Certificate

Advanced Certificate (Minimum Entry Requirements)

At least 3 Subsidiary Passes obtained at "A" Level or C+ at Form 4 in the 8-4-4, education system.

Application Procedure

The application procedure entails: Paying the application fee, collecting, filling and returning the application forms to the Academic Registrar's Office at either Main or Kampala Campus with copies of "0" Level (UCE), "A" Level (UACE) and other relevant Pass Slips and Certificates and one colored passport size photograph **OR** applications can be done online through the admissions portal
