NDEJJE UNIVERSITY HOLDS 26TH GRADUATION CEREMONY

LUWERO, UGANDA: Ndejje University has today held its 26th Graduation ceremony officiated by the Minister of Science, Innovation and technology Dr. Monica Musenero Masanza at its main campus in Luwero.

The members of the Board of trustees and consortium, University council, university stakeholders including parents and guardians, sponsors, suppliers, banks and non-governmental organizations, attended the ceremony.

This year's theme for the graduation is "**Bearing fruits that abide**" as drawn from John 15:16. This emphasizes our mandate as a Christian based Anglican university to not only bear fruits that abide but also bear good fruits through the products that we nurture and our services to the students, community outreach and wider society.

Our teaching and learning, research, community outreach and mentoring is designed to produce God-fearing citizens who are ready to serve and work innovatively, transform the world as they diligently and faithfully bear fruits to the glory of God.

A total of 1067 students graduated with 433 (40.6%) females and 634 (59.4%) males. 44 of these obtained first class degrees (23 females and 21 males). The overall best student Ms. Nagitta Brenda, Bachelor of Business Administration (Accounting and Finance) scored a CGPA of 4.79. Of the 44 first class degrees, Four (4) students were from the faculty of Engineering.

Speaking at the graduation ceremony, Dr Monica Musenero emphasized the need for the graduates to be agile and self-driven as the workforce environment is looking for people who are productive and bring fourth fruits that abide. The impact of the fruits should have a multiplier effect that can be carried on for generations and across generations.

She further applauded Ndejje University for being at the helm of carrying out innovations which are geared towards impacting society and providing solutions to present and future community challenges which the country can reap from.

Ndejje University remains committed to providing holistic education and congratulates all graduates upon the successful completion of their studies.
